

From the Agronomy Desk...

As we work our way through November, let's take a little time to analyze what was needed to produce our crops this season. What were the costs of our inputs and how did the crop turn out? The harvest overall is going fairly well with a majority of soybeans in the bin. Corn harvest is also in full swing with some growers already done with dry corn. Moisture in corn is coming in the low twenties and below. Corn yields are varying above average to below average.

With harvest comes fall tillage, lime should be applied if needed. This can be done with variable rate or flat rate. We should be applying manure with our crop nutrient demands for next year in mind as we empty the pits. I also recommend taking manure samples so we can see what value the manure has. If you are in need of manure or soil sampling, let us know as we still have time to get it done.

It's also that time of the year to purchase seeds for next spring. This is the time to buy, as seeds are at the best price. Consider what worked for you this past year and what didn't perform as well.

Lets' get a jump start on your nutrient management plans in the coming weeks as well.
